Nothing matters attitude
sloppy appearance, lack of interest in previous activities



Mood changes
temper flare-ups, irritability



Friend problems
switching friends, secretive or defensive about friends

Physical and mental problems

memory lapse, poor concentration, bloodshot eyes, lack of coordination, slurred speech



Any sudden change in behavior

School problems

poor attendance, low grades, disciplinary issues



Family problems

rebellion against family rules

Alcohol presence
smelling it on his or her breath, finding it in their backpack or locker

* These warning signs may signify other problems as well.
